## EDITORIAL

As another season bites the dust we have the potential for another issue with the governing authorities. Last June the AGM of ETTA passed a resolution to have individual membership, which they had been trying to achieve for many years. The initial forms were distributed and the response was less than 20% so the data was pretty pointless, then they made the situation even worse by having forms that asked for ethnic background etc – certain to create issues with, lets be frank, an ageing and fairly conservative audience.

Well we now have no choice in the matter individual membership has to be implemented next season whether we like it or not. So the question is how to manage the process. The league has deliberately not put forward any rule changes to the AGM as the initial year will be a learning process but expect rules for next year's AGM. One thing that the ETTA did learn from the aborted previous attempts is to simplify the registration process. We are hoping that only basic information is required and we can then add to it for our own team registration process.

So there are two things that need to be sorted. Firstly the information gathering process and secondly the fiscal management. It will be much easier if the task is undertaken by club secretaries and the information relayed to me by electronic transfer as much of this information is already held by the clubs but this may be nullified by ETTA's systems. With regard to fees. The actual registration fees will be decided at the ETTA AGM held in June but the expected figure is around £5.80 for seniors. We currently get charged about £20 for each four man team so the figures are similar. Remember that a player registers only once regardless of the number of leagues he/she plays in so, in this area, the net income for the ETTA will be reduced.

Regarding the past season most competitions ran smoothly but the inclement weather around Christmas did disrupt quite a few matches with Easter falling in the season creating a few more postponements. Once again thanks must go to Phil for the management of the website. Hopefully, next season, more players will take advantage of the 'enter a scoresheet' option. The tournament was a reasonable success but a few more entries would be welcomed. Still without that the Presentation Evening would not be worthwhile. Please see information later in this report regarding this season's effort on June 19<sup>th</sup> (carefully chosen as the evening WC match is Cameroon v Denmark)

## **ADTTL Chairman's Report for 2010 AGM**

1. We started with 45 teams in 4 divisions (one down on last year) and finished with the same number, with no teams dropping out. The season officially finished on 12<sup>th</sup> April 2010 but there were a few matches still outstanding to be completed, before Dave Brown could finalise the League Tables.
2. George Brown celebrated his 90<sup>th</sup> birthday last season has decided to retire from League play. It is a truly remarkable achievement and he has seen and coped with many changes to the sport during his career. I am sure that you will join me in wishing him well in whatever he turns his hand to. What an example to us all.
3. The ETTA will have a new way that players are registered as members from next season. This is in line with the wishes of Sport England, ETTA's funding body, who require accurate participation numbers for future funding. Players will be required to affiliate directly with ETTA each year and will be given a registration number that will stay with members for life but with membership being renewed annually. This individual affiliation means that a player only needs to pay one fee per season regardless of how many Leagues he/she plays in.

The fees will be in the order of £5.64 (seniors), £2.82 (cadets and juniors) and £2.50 (associate members) but these fees will need to be ratified or amended at the ETTA AGM on 10<sup>th</sup> July this year. This is not an additional cost for players to bear, but the same as the league previously paid to ETTA in the form as an annual player registration fee from the Club registration fees paid to the Aldershot League, prior to the start of a new season. These costs now include an element for Civil Liability Insurance. For the first year Local Leagues will be responsible for collection of these payments for their members, unless a player has obtained their own membership on-line, and been informed accordingly by the players that they have paid elsewhere. Leagues will be sent data ETTA already hold on the Leagues players, with a request from ETTA that the data will be verified or amended and sent back to ETTA. This will probably be done via Club Secretaries. ETTA will send membership cards with names and registration numbers to the League for the players that are registered with ETTA, for distribution to clubs for their players.

## **Coaching Officers Report for 2010 ADTTL AGM**

1. The core of my work as ADTTL Coaching Officer is focussed on our Collingwood Coaching headquarters in Camberley. Pete Good and Norrie Short provide invaluable backup and help to be able to keep the centre open on hand to assist other players, and Pete and Andrew Davies the Leagues newly qualified coach assist me in providing advice and coaching and player help. We have 8 quality modern compact or rollaway tables and have recently bought one of Ash's older tables to be able to offer a ninth table when the player numbers dictate. Player numbers have been unprecedented this season, with between 20 and 36 each night ranging from Division 1, to non league players, and I am pleased that we have an increasing number of junior and new players attending that will hopefully feed through to the League. Phil Snelson who runs the ADTTL Web has been an invaluable contact point for the League, and has been sending a steady stream of players new to the area for evaluation, and help with finding suitable teams. I will always be on hand to assist any league players to improve their standard, or to modify their game to cater for injury or ill health.
2. Over the Coaching Year (July to April), we have taken £1499.50 in Subs (still at £1.50 for the 10<sup>th</sup> year) and paid out £495 (£50 for the Ash table, £390 for Hall use fees, and £55 for a table tennis balls squash and plastic cups). We have sent £1532.00 from the Subs collected plus the £89.80 float we started with into the ADTTL Coaching fund. The ADTTL Coaching account stands at £2682.25 (a profit on the season of about £1000) and this will allow us to continually improve the stock of tables, and to have a pretty good buffer should the hall hire fees rise dramatically, as I have been expecting each year during the last 9 years.
3. I have am always available to assist schools or youth clubs in the leagues catchment area Andrew Davies, from Frimley TTC attended and passed an ETTA level 1 Coaches Course which was part sponsored by the league, and together with Keith Falconer who occasionally comes to the centre increases the number of active and qualified League Coaches to 3. If anybody else wishes to consider a coaching course to help other League players, please contact me, as ETTA and ADTTL subsidies are available to help with costs of the courses and qualification.
4. I attend meetings at Winchester with the Hampshire Sports Partnership on a regular basis to discuss the Hampshire TT action and development plan for the county, which focuses on the development of our sport in schools and youth Clubs, and will hopefully produce more players. I also sit on the Hampshire Table Tennis Association Management Council as their Vice Chairman and Minute Secretary and attend coach education seminars.

5. The Hampshire Youth Games (Table Tennis) will be held at Wavell School on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> June from 10:00 to 16:00. I already have the offer of assistance from some ever present stalwarts to help stage the event, but any further offers even for part of the day would be gratefully appreciated. It's a great day out helping young players with their first ever tournament, and helpers get a meal and a quality sweatshirt for their trouble.

## CUP FINAL REPORTS

### FIRST DIVISION

As it turned out this was the most exciting of the KO finals and it was, unusually, the first to be played. The finalists were Central A and Broadmoor A and the match played at Broadmoor with Central as the home team. Central used Paul Massey, Phil Snelson and Norman Swift whilst Broadmoor went with Clive Banham, Barry Morten and Mark Handcock. Broadmoor drew first blood with Clive getting the better of Paul but Central hit straight back with a win for Phil against Barry. The next set was Norman against Mark and would be classed as one of those that could go either way. Not surprisingly it went the distance with Mark ultimately getting the better of Norman to ease Broadmoor ahead again. This was quickly nullified with an easy victory for Phil over Clive. Broadmoor then went ahead again when Mark got the better of Paul and yet again Central squared the match with victory for Norman over Barry. The seventh set is generally played by the best players from each team and so it was that the two undefeated players, Phil and Mark, squared up. The first two games went narrowly to Mark but Phil fought back to take it to a fifth game which he ultimately won 11-8 to put Central ahead for the first time in the evening. The next set was Norman against Clive and this also went all the way with Clive bagging an excellent win to square the match again. Enter the two players yet to taste success in the evening to decide the fate of the trophy. Needless to say the first four games were shared and then Paul pulled away in the final game to take it 11-3 and secure the trophy for Central. A team effort with all three players winning but the undefeated Phil Snelson the obvious star of the evening.

## SECOND DIVISION

The second division final was played between two mid-table teams, Cody B and Ash D. Jock Docherty, Kin Chan and Stuart Stone turned out for Cody whilst Nigel Tustin, Frank Winnard and Bob Murrell were the Ash team. Cody raced into a 3-0 lead and never looked back, Jock beating Nigel, Kin getting the better of Frank and Stuart overcoming Bob. Nigel stemmed the flow with a win over Kin but Jock put Cody within touching distance of the cup with victory Bob. Frank gave Ash some hope with success over Stuart but the win was sealed with Kin getting the better of Bob to give Cody the trophy 5-2.

## THIRD DIVISION

The third division was equally one-sided. Frimley D played Bourne B. Frimley paraded Gary Nicholson, Robeen Roopun and Margaret Thornton whilst Bourne had their strongest trio in the form of Phil Larking, Peter Butler and Andy Barnard. Although every set was keenly contested the only wins for Frimley were Robeen against Phil and Margaret over Peter meaning that Bourne took the cup 7-2 with Andy undefeated.

## FOURTH DIVISION FINAL

The fourth division final was between Farnham Cohesion B and Tennis J. Farnham had their strongest possible side out with Geoff Green, Chris Saville and John Saville. Tennis used Graham Dorey, John Davis and John Page. The result was never in doubt with Farnham Cohesion winning 8-1 with John Page beating John Saville for the single success for Tennis.

Unusually, this season, there have been no instances of teams doing the league and cup double which generally happens at least twice every year.

## HANDICAP CUP FINAL

The Handicap Cup Final featured two teams from the third division, Tennis H and Farnham Cohesion A. Tennis used Colin Baggott (handicap 35), Eliot Tilley (30) and Paul Jarvis (28) whilst Farnham utilised Chris Saville (20), Dean Robertson (27) and Dong Ming Lau (34).

With three youngsters playing plus Colin who has just returned to the sport the handicaps may have been a bit awry. As it happens it was still quite close. Colin started by overcoming a 15 point deficit to beat Chris by 3 points. Dean then easily beat Eliot and Dong did similarly against Paul to take Farnham into the lead. The next set was pivotal to the evening with Eliot playing Chris. Chris had a 10 point lead but with Eliot winning the first game 11-3 the omens did not look good but Chris dug in and took the next two games to make the fourth game academic and Farnham stretched their lead. The next set was Colin against Dong with Dong having a single point advantage on handicap. The four games were shared but with

the scores level Colin gained victory as he was making up the handicap. Dean then displayed his excellent form of the last months of the season by getting the better of Paul to give Farnham a 4-2 advantage. Eliot against Dong probably produced the best table tennis of the evening. Yet again the four games were shared but Eliot eased to victory with two points to spare thanks to his four point handicap.
